EASTERN PRIME stumbled at the start, was well reserved in the two path during the early stages, ranged into contention after entering the turn, swung three wide into the lane, made steady progress on the leader after being given encouragement in upper stretch, reached even terms in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and proved best under active handling. READ THE POST well rated while tracking the pacesetter, made a quick inside move to take command midway on the turn, while still not being asked for her best, established a clear advantage by the time she reached the quarter pole, dug in when challenged by the top one leaving the furlong marker, proved no match during the final sixteenth, but continued on willingly to be clearly second best. TYPIFY chased the leader for a half, and had enough left to best the rest. WISE PITCH saved ground until the quarter pole and improved her position during the stretch drive with a mild rally. LA GIOIA DITUTTI was involved in bumping incident with a pair of rivals during the run down the backstretch, tired after going a half. LADY WYNNE exchanged bumps with a duo soon after leaving the starting gate, raced three wide and gave way. APPROVED BY MOM traded bumps with LADY WYNNE and LA GIOIA DUTTI while travelling along the backstretch, proceeded on a four wide trip around the turn and tired. MOCHA SHAKE showed the way for a half from the two path before faltering.

WILD POPPY was placed under a firm hold while tracking the leader during the initial half, gained ample opportunity to be eased outward when DURLORES began dropping back during the run around the bend, responded positively when given her cue in upper stretch, advanced steadily towards the front, drew along side RIDE ON JOSEPHINE leaving the sixteenth pole and proved best under good handling. RIDE ON JOSEPHINE placed under a firm hold, was content the pacesetter from the three path during the opening half, launched her bid when ready approaching the quarter pole, took charge midstretch under a vigorous hand ride, was put to the test by the top one a sixteenth mile later, succumbed, but continued on willingly to be a clear second. STORMY DIXIE set the pace racing towards the inside, came under assault from RIDE ON JOSEPHINE as the field neared the head of the stretch, offered resistance before relinquishing the lead with a furlong remaining, but continued on well to the wire to secure the show. RETOOL stumbled at the start, took the inside route before swinging outward at the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. SERELA'S SONG was no factor. DURLORES left the starting gate alertly, was taken back and placed under a snug hold for over three furlongs, failed to keep pace after being asked during the run around the bend and steadily tired thereafter.

Z CATS MEOW established command soon after the start, cut the fractions along the inside while facing only light pressure, was let out a notch after turning for home, scampered away to a sizeable advantage by the time she reached the eighth pole and safely maintained it while being kept busy. CASA DI VINO reserved during the opening half, was roused in upper lane and came home with good courage to garner place honors. LADY AT THE LAKE well placed while racing towards the inside, was angled outward prior to being asked for run, heading for the stretch, failed to fire when set down. DREARY DAY steadied repeatedly during the run down the backstretch to avoid running up on a rival, was swung out to the four path to gain clearance, advanced three to four wide around the turn to reach a contending position, but failed to sustain the bid after entering the stretch. PERSKY'S LOVE had no rally. BIRD IN HAND failed to menace. MARGARO lunged at the break, pursued the leader three wide for a half, steadied momentarily at the quarter pole as LADY AT THE LAKE swung out and folded. LIGHTNING DREAMS saved ground to no avail.
