MIA D'COUGAR raced prominently to the outside of BEAR'S LIGHTNING, drew alongside that one early backstretch, dueled two-wide to the end and gained a narrow advantage in the stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. INITFORREAL stalked the pace in hand, bid three-wide on the far turn, dueled to the end but was outfinished. ESSON LAKE stalked the pace five then four-wide on the first turn, moved inward to the second path for the run through the far turn, chased to the stretch then finished determinedly in vain. VALID SQUEEZE, off a step slowly, remained unhurried but in range to the far turn, was hustled along the rail to the stretch then evened out.

RAG AND BONE, rated in range, closed between rivals on the far turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely to no avail. ALKMAAR stalked the pace, bid midturn, vied briefly but was headed at the top of the stretch and chased the winner home. GREENAPPLE MARTINI, rated early, pulled early backstretch then settled, moved to the inside late backstretch, stalked on the turn angling out to the third path then evened out in the stretch. SNOW PATCHES led quickly, set a reserved pace, was engaged midturn, yielded quickly and tired. SWEET SASSAFRAS stalked the early pace, dropped back on the backstretch, chased on the turn then tired.

GET RICH QUICK, rated early, posted a bold move to take the lead midturn, was quickly engaged by the early leader, dueled and drove clear at the top of the stretch then yielded midstretch and gave way. MEDJOOL led early, set a reserved pace, was headed midturn but quickened and dueled to late turn, yielded, angled out upper stretch and finished gamely.

AWAKE BY NOON settled well off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn but never reached contention. HIGH SPEED held a short early lead under pressure, was headed at the turn, stalked from the rail then tired upper stretch.

BUG'S BOY raced in range while two and three-wide, cut to the rail at the top of the stretch, launched his drive but quickly evened out. DEGRAFF raced off the pace, angled from the second to the fifth path on the turn, was hustled along but never reached contention. WAR LAP raced off the pace, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the final sixteenth. RUBATO D'ORO raced midpack, was roused three-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. JUNIOR ATTORNEY forced the pace, bid three-wide late backstretch and took a short lead, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. TANNERS CROSSING was used early, dueled on the main track, backed away at the turn, was roused but showed no response and faded.
