STORMY GIGI crossed over from the outside to make a clear early lead down the backstretch, opened up on her foes at the top of the lane and held on under left and right handed encouragement. ALICE was off slowly and awkwardly to be far back in the early going, began to make up ground on the turn and rallied boldly down the center of the track in the final furlong. SHE'S BORRACHO chased the early leaders inside a three horse spread, saved ground on the turn and rallied when asked in the final furlong. STORM THE CHURCH chased the early leaders on the outside of two rivals, rallied in the final furlong but could not gain enough ground. CANDACE GOLD pressed the early leader from the inside, angled outside on the turn but weakened in the final furlong. SARABELLA MIA hopped at the start to be away slowly, was far back down the backstretch and could not mount a rally down the lane. MARQUISITE stalked the early leaders between horses, fell back at the top of the lane and was no factor thereafter. ROYAL REASON pressed the early pace from the outside, began to give way on the turn and had nothing left in the final furlong.

TAMERIN angled in and stalked outside a rival, was between horses in midstretch, took the lead between foes under urging in deep stretch and proved best. ONCE UPON A GRACE (IRE) three deep early, pulled her way along a bit off the rail to chase the pace, came out into the stretch, was three wide in midstretch and finished with interest. STASH sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, held on well to deep stretch, could not match the top pair late but saved the show. GOLD GODDESS stalked the pace inside, came out a bit for room past midstretch and just missed a minor award between foes late. EMMY DARLING between horses early, chased outside then three deep, came out five wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. MERRILY stalked outside a rival or between foes, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RIDE ME FAST settled off the pace outside a rival to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. ALLABOUTIMAGE (NZ) saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a threat.

SENSATIONAL SCORE chased between horses then outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and edged a foe late for third. SOUPY had speed inside then pulled a bit while stalking the winner, bid alongside that one on the backstretch, tracked again just off the fence on the second turn, found the inside in the stretch nd lost the show late. SKIPPY DUE stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, swung out into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. PISTOL PETE AFLEET pulled his way along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back outside a rival, found the fence again on the second turn and weakened. CAUSE was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. FUNNY ME (GB) a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, dropped well back, was eased in the stretch and walked off.

MISS GEORGIE GIRL chased between horses then outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the turn, swung out into the stretch, angled inward past midstretch, waited momentarily off heels in deep stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. GIVEME ONEREASON had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. WARREN'S SWAP FOX broke in a bit, was between horses early then chased just off the rail, angled in for the turn and did not rally. MY SECRET WEAPON off a bit slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SERENE SERENA allowed to settle outside a rival then just off the rail to the stretch and failed to menace. FULLBRIDLED'S SIS pulled four wide early then stalked outside a rival, continued off the rail, dropped back and angled in some leaving the turn and weakened.

UNUSUAL TREAT stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MY SPANISH FLING broke a bit slowly then steadied when shut off, settled outside a rival, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. ANUNDENIABLYHAPPY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back into the stretch and until past midstretch and weakened late. GONNA SEE WEST off a bit slowly and squeezed back, settled just out from the inside, swung wide into the stretch and was not a threat. CAPTIVATING LYRICS broke outward, chased between foes early, stalked inside on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. HOSTILE REACTION unhurried along the inside on the backstretch and turn, failed to menace. MISSTRAILCITYZONE stalked three deep between foes, dropped back off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. MAR FINA dueled between horses, fell back a bit off the rail leaving the turn, was between foes into the stretch and also weakened. WARRENS STORMYMOON prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
