ALL TOGETHER set the pace on the inside, was clear between calls leaving the clubhouse turn, responded in upper stretch and dug in late to hold on. STREET MOVE was forced out very wide to avoid the spill on the first turn, recovered to track the leaders, angled out at the top of the lane and closed gamely outside. EON vied inside, was bumped and forced to steady at the three quarter pole, moved up to press the pace on the backside, bid at the quarter pole and weakened. PEACEFUL CROWD vied early on, took back nearing the first turn, was forced to steady on the turn, chased three wide on the backside and weakened. NET PRESENT VALUE was steadied and forced wide on the clubhouse turn, then failed to threaten. ARHAT was outrun early and eliminated at the three quarter pole. MASK AND WIG was eliminated on the first turn. GRAND BLACK JAK broke in the air and was eliminated on the first turn. BACKTRACKEN was eliminated on the first turn. CORREDOR'S SONG fell over a fallen rival. BALLADO ALERT bumped with EON, appeared to clip heels and fell at the three quarter pole. After a Stewards' Inquiry the race was declared official.
