KEEP SIX raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. LONG PANTS stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide through the turn then evened out late. MAJESTIC TRIBUTE raced midpack, was roused late turn but lacked a strong closing response. KINSTAR vied briefly, was cleared at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. STAGWORKS, off slowly, trailed the field, angled out to the sixth path through the turn then lacked a rally.

EAGLE POISE raced in midpack early, closed on the backstretch then stalked on the turn, bid upper stretch, drove clear then held under steady pressure. BACKGAMMON was always prominent, backed away late turn, angled out a bit but was blocked at the top of the stretch, angled out then rallied gamely and was gaining. ALTONA ROAD raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, angled out upper stretch and rallied determinedly. COFFEE BAR, always prominent, dueled from early turn, shook clear briefly at the top of the stretch, was headed then chased to the end. BRITISH BANKER, rated early, was hustled on the turn, angled out late turn then lacked a strong closing response. SENOR GONZAGA (IRE) stalked up close, dropped back a bit on the turn, stalked to the stretch then evened out. RED RIVAL raced midpack, bid early turn, vied, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid but was headed by the winner, chased briefly and evened out. COOL HAND DUKE raced midpack between horses, was hustled five and six-wide late turn then evened out in the final furlong. DIAMOND MOON, rated midpack, dropped back on the turn, chased to the stretch then had no closing response.

YAROSLAV, well back early, closed late turn and launched an all out drive. SEISMIC FORCE moved clear early on the backstretch, set a reserved pace, was headed midstretch and chased but was tiring at the end. CATCH AIR raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn and evened out in the late stages. PIT ALLEY raced midpack, closed on the turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch then lacked a strong closing response. STOLONBOY pulled early, stalked the pacesetter, chased from midturn then flattened out in the stretch. HIS SMOOTHNESS, well back early, was hustled while angling out four-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. SILENT KNIGHT raced midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn but lacked a rally. FLASHY CONSORT set pressured pace in hand,clear top str,engaged midstretch, bested the leader but was passed a sixteenth out. HASSAYAMPA pressed the pace from the inside, chased on the turn then evened out midstretch. GOLD LEAF ROSE stalked on the backstretch then pressed the pace on the turn, failed with a bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, was all out but tired late.
