G T'S GONE DANCING, in touch between horses, closed four and five-wide on the turn then finished all out. SOROCABA broke outward, raced in touch between foes, came three and four-wide through the turn but evened out in the stretch. RIGHT REWARD, in range, bid at the turn, dueled, yielded at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired in the final furlong. PLAYFUL PUSSYCAT raced off the pace, raced four and five-wide on the turn, finished all out but never reached contention. WELLIES showed brief speed, stalked on the turn, chased into the stretch and flattened out. HO MASUBI raced off the pace, was roused early turn then lacked a stretch response. IT HURTS stalked to the turn then faded under a ride.

PEDEGRAL stalked the pace, was used late backstretch and took a run at the leader entering the turn, was quickly cleared, chased to the stretch and finished determinedly. WAR LAP raced off the pace, was hustled into the turn, chased to the stretch and finished gamely. TWO VIOLINS, clear quickly, set the pace, quickened early turn, was collared a furlong out and yielded. MERCADO, in range inside, chased into the stretch then evened out in the final 16th. FERNBROOK, in range, closed five and six-wide on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. FLESHNER raced off the pace, was hustled into the turn, was roused near the 1/4 pole, came four-wide into the stretch but evened out. PASSPORT JOE, sandwiched just out, trailed the field and never reached contention. SADDLE CREEK stalked from between horses, faded under a ride on the turn then lacked a closing response.

MCGREGOR STREET set a pressured pace, dueled late turn, was headed a furlong out, chased briefly and tired. LEGENDARY STACEY raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, then finished gamely between foes. NIAGARA EXPRESS, well back early, was hustled angling from three to six-wide on the turn but never reached contention. KALUA ON THE ROCKS stumbled at the start, moved up quickly and forced the pace, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled and wore down the early pacesetter in deep stretch but failed to contain the winner. MAKANI led quickly, set a pressured pace, dueled through the stretch then yielded in the late stages. ROVINA raced off the pace, was roused four-wide late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied belatedly. FLASHY CONSORT stalked early, settled off the pace late backstretch, chased on the turn then evened out in the final 16th. MORO MOO raced off the pace, was hustled angling from four to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. CATURIANA, rated off the pace, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out.

SWEET DISCRETION, off a step slowly, was hustled on the backstretch and got up inside rivals to press the pace, was checked in tight quarters nearing the turn, chased along the rail on the turn but lacked a stretch response.

LURCHUS ORILIOS raced off the pace between foes, was set down late turn, angled five-wide approaching the stretch then rallied gamely but late. WISDOM ADMIRAL forced the early pace, stalked on the backstretch, chased through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. SCANDALOUS AFFAIR raced midpack between horses, chased two-wide into the stretch then finished determinedly along the inside. MIGHTY SILVER, in range, was roused four-wide late turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. KINNAIRD, off a step slowly, saved ground and rallied belatedly. AWESOME RUBIANO, off slowly, raced well back, encountered traffic at the top of the stretch then rallied late when clear. A TAD DEVINE traded the lead repeatedly with DANIAL S, failed to match strides with his last challenge early on the final turn, chased briefly and tired in the stretch. I'M THE MANAGER, in range, came four and five-wide through the far turn then flattened out with a 16th to run. JUSTA DEMON, off slowly and always well back, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. DANJON, close early, faded on the backstretch and lacked a further response. CLEARVIEW HEIGHTS, off poorly, raced six-wide into the first turn, was on the fringe of striking distance in the middle of the pack while three-deep on the far turn but tired in the stretch.
