TERPSICHOREAN raced up along along the inside, took the lead nearing the eight fence, battled inside through the turn, dug in while battling heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. DYNASKI was well placed along the inside, swung out while gaining on the turn, lodged a bid outside the winner leaving the final fence and was outfinished in the closing strides. ARCADIUS raced well back for a good part of the way while saving ground, closed gap the gap in upper stretch, angled to the inside of the leaders while rallying in midstretch and finished willingly to gain a share. TAX RULING took the lead soon after the start, set the pace in hand for a good part of the way and tired leaving the final turn. LEAD US NOT raced in the middle of the pack well off the inside to the final turn and steadily tired thereafter. NORTHERN BAY failed to mount a serious rally. FRA DIAVOLO (ARG) raced just behind the leaders between horses, steadied in traffic in upper stretch and gave way. ZOZIMUS faded on the final turn and left the course nearing the ninth fence.

ROMAN CHESTNUT stalked early from outside, advanced four wide on the turn and lacked a late response. WHISPERED saved ground to no avail. SHE WEARS THE BEST raced just off the pace between rivals to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. ISN'T SHE GRAND stumbled after being bumped soundly at the start and failed to threaten while racing wide. WATER OF LIFE stumbled at the start, pressed the winner from outside for a half and gave way.

TAPITSFLY sprinted clear on the rail, raced uncontested on the lead for five furlongs, dug in when challenged leaving the turn, repulsed a bid from SMART SEATTLE in upper stretch and edged clear under right hand urging. SMART SEATTLE settled in good position while three wide for a half, made a sharp move from outside to draw on even terms with the winner leaving the turn, battled outside into midstretch but couldn't stay with TAPITSFLY through the final eighth. BEAUTIFUL SONG broke awkwardly, rushed up four wide entering the backstretch, raced within striking distance to the top of the stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. LUCKY TO BE ME was well placed along the rail to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. MADDIE'S ODYSSEY was rated between horses for a good part of the way and lacked a late response. LISA'S KITTEN raced in hand between horses for six furlongs and failed to mount a serious rally. WRITE WHEN READY pressed the winner in the two path to the turn and gave way.

ETCHED pressed the pace from outside to the turn, shook loose in upper stretch and drew clear under steady right hand urging. DR. PLEASURE raced in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, rallied along the rail midway on the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track. NATIONAL PRIDE settled along the inside, lodged a mild move on the rail midway on the turn and flattened out. FAMOUS PATRIOT was outrun for a half, gained outside on the turn, altered course to the inside of DR. PLEASURE in upper stretch and lacked a late response. TRUE RESURGENCE set the pace inside to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. GIANT CHIEFTAN failed to mount a serious rally. TIMBER RESERVE chased outside for five furlongs, drifted out considerably at the quarter pole and gave way. MINT LANE broke poorly and was never close thereafter.
