MOON TOWN settled in hand within striking distance, angled in leaving the turn, slipped through and drew even with a furlong to run, shook off his challengers and gradually edged clear. NORMANDRUTH was unhurried into stride, advanced along the inside through the bend, angled to the outside entering the stretch and closed willingly to earn the place. EAST TO WEST tracked the pace three deep, ranged up to engage the leaders entering the stretch, poked his head in front nearing the furlong marker, but weakened during the drive and settled for a minor award. THE BIG FINISHER veered in at the start, was sent to the fore to set the pressured pace off of the inside, was collared between horses leaving the turn, faltered in the final furlong and faded. TROOPER D was jostled at the start, settled into stride toward the outside, angled in entering the turn, made a mild rally from between rivals but failed to threaten. PAGOSA PEAK pressed the pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. GREAT CRUSADE saved ground to little avail. KING EXPRESS failed to respond. NACHO CORONA was hustled along four wide in the second flight, but came up empty after five furlongs and retreated. MALCOM'S DELITE broke a step slow, made a mild gain from between horses with a half mile to run, but failed to sustain the drive. AXTON PARK was through early.

EL INDY settled under a snug hold, advanced four wide through the second turn, split horses entering the stretch and was fully extended to wear down MOTOWN SHUFFLE in the final strides. MOTOWN SHUFFLE attended the pace along the inside, shifted out and bid between horses with a quarter to run, forged a narrow lead and battled gamely but grudgingly gave way late. MONTENEGRO KNIGHT broke slowly and was unhurried into stride, closed swiftly from between horses through the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, lugged in through the drive but continued on fairly well to earn the show. BOULDER TIGER settled saving ground, shifted out to launch his bid, dropped back to the inside entering the lane, was blocked with a furlong to run, found room late and came again once clear. J T KINGFISHER was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. BIGGERBADDRBETTER stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to engage the leaders nearing the quarter pole, but weakened during the drive and faded. HALMI hopped at the start to get away slowly, was unhurried toward the inside, got through to make a mild gain but was never a factor. CITIZEN JOHN disputed pace two wide, weakened with a furlong to run, steadied from tight quarters when MONTENEGRO KNIGHT came in and showed little thereafter. SPARK OF HUMOR was unhurried into stride, made a mild gain four wide but was never a factor. PASS THE VICE failed to respond. AN HEIR OF MAGIC chased the pace three wide, weakened after six furlongs, steadied near the five-sixteenths marker when MONTENEGRO KNIGHT came in and quickly dropped out. PRINCE JENNA vied for the lead along the inside to the stretch and stopped.

DANA'S BELL set the pressured pace from between horses, shook clear entering the stretch, was kept to task and maintained a safe advantage. FORTHEBOYSATTHEBAR settled in hand, came four wide to make her bid, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. SISTERS FIVE attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but failed to menace the winner. AFTER DARK vied for the lead from between horses, steadied and was shuffled back with a half mile to run, advanced three wide through the turn, waited in traffic mid way through the bend, angled in and came again to improve her position through the stretch.
