GRACE HAPPENS forced the pace four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. PLEASE CALL ME alternated for the lead in the three path and faded. SHE'S DUE stumbled at the start unseating her rider.

BEAU'S VALENTINE set the pace near the rail, repulsed a bid by the runner up and CLASSIC EMILY entering the stretch, drew clear then lasted late. POPPICICLE TOES behind the leaders three wide, challenged the winner late on the turn, could not keep pace with that one in upper stretch but came again late to be steadily gaining in the final sixteenth. CLASSIC EMILY within striking distance, moved to a challenging position four wide late on the turn, dropped back a bit into the stretch then made a mild late gain. BLIZZARDCONDITIONS well placed early, was a bit hesitant between POPPICICLE TOES and the inside rail near the furlong marker then had no late bid. REACHFORTHECASTLE outrun early, swung out six wide leaving the turn and could not threaten. CHUBBY outrun in the three path, was no factor. PRAYER OF SILENCE closest to the pace off the inside, gave way. WEE BIT FANCY within striking distance, came five wide into the stretch and broke down just inside the furlong marker.
