FINAL ENDING stalked the pace three deep, forged command with a furlong to run, edged clear then was fully extended to keep his entry mate at bay. PATTI'S KITTEN was shuffled back at the start and unhurried into stride, swung to the outside leaving the turn, finished full of run and was gaining with every stride. ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR hopped at the start, rushed to contention from between horses, angled in leaving the turn to continue the drive, shifted to the outside of FINAL ENDING for the final furlong but lacked the needed late response. DONIPHON opened clear to set the pace, disputed the issue to the final furlong and gave way. HAITIAN HERO contended between horses, checked from tight quarters with five furlongs to run, angled out and came again with a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. RUM N TING settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch and improved his position late. VENICE BEACH was unhurried into stride between rivals, came five wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. SHOW TRIAL contended between horses to the stretch and faded. HOOTEN TOWN HILL chased the pace four wide for five furlongs and tired. MAX THE KNIFE saved ground to no avail. SEEKING THE ORANGE was through early.

TEMPO FIVE settled in hand along the inside, was bottled up between horses from the five-sixteenths pole to nearing the furlong marker, worked his way to the outside to find room and finished with a rush once clear. TRYING BRIAN attended the pace off of the inside, swung to the outside leaving the turn, shook clear entering the stretch, kept on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. ONESHOTAWAY dropped well back at once, came four wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the show. CELLULOID HERO dueled for the lead two wide, weakened during the drive and gave way. ISLAND WARRIOR stalked the pace three deep, closed swiftly through the turn, loomed boldly entering the stretch but faltered from between horses in the final furlong and faded. DARLING MON dueled for the lead along the inside to the stretch and tired. NO FAULT advanced from between rivals for a contending position, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out.
