MR. SATURDAYNIGHT stalked the early leader around the first turn and down the backstretch, rallied between horses in the lane to get up in a driving finish. SETSUKO saved ground while chasing the early leaders around the first turn and down the backstretch, continued to save ground on the second turn, angled to the rail to rally but had to settle for second best. TAKE A HARD LOOK moved up outside a rival down the backstretch, entered the lane three wide, led briefly at the top of the lane and gradually weakened in the final furlong. MAGIC MAX went to the front from the outset to establish a clear early lead, led the way into the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging in early stretch and weakened. LIGHTNIN' UP saved ground while being outrun into the first turn, chased the leaders down the backstretch and failed to mount a rally in the lane. SUMMERS AT DELMAR was outrun into the first turn and down the backstretch, lost contact with the field into the lane and could not make up any ground.

SEEUAT STICKNSTEIN stalked the pace inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. SWEET TIGGER dueled between horses then inside into and on the turn, inched away in the stretch, drifted out in the final furlong and held second. COO CACHOO between foes early, prompted the pace inside then was shuffled back leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and bested the others. RAPTOR FORCE forced the pace four wide then three deep into and on the turn, drifted in through the final furlong and weakened. SHOW THE FLAG settled outside then off the rail, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally. CATCH MY TALE dueled three deep then between foes on the backstretch and turn, was in a bit tight off heels while falling back some into the stretch and weakened. RITZVILLE chased between foes then outside a rival, came out on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.

TRIBUL WITCH wide early, stalked outside, bid three deep leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, drifted out and in some from the whip in the drive and held second. QUE SERA SERA stalked between horses then off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out past midstretch and edged a rival for third. DANIELLA ROTH chased between horses then off the rail, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and finished with interest to just miss the show. WAKAYA hopped a bit at the start, settled outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. NEW CITIZEN a bit slow to begin, settled inside, split horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally inside. CEE'S HARMONY stumbled at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and was could not offer the necessary response. DANCING JEANNIE sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled three deep, inched away briefly on the turn, battled between foes leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. HEARDABIRD stalked between foes then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and also weakened. SMOK'EM OVER a bit slow to begin, went up inside to duel for the lead while pulling under a hold, was shuffled back a bit leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. EXAGGERATED RUNNER dropped back outside on the backstretch then settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was outrun.

MAST TRACK sent along inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside a rival and dueled on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead into the stretch, drifted out a bit and inched away in the drive, fought back outside the winner past midstretch and was second best. BECRUX (ITY) pulled a bit and stalked just off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. EL GATO MALO three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and was edged for third. DAKOTA PHONE pulled inside then stalked just off the rail, went three deep into and on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LIMESTONE EDGE settled off the rail then outside a rival, went between foes on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. TAMBORIM had speed outside the runner-up then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the lane. COLONY (IRE) broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again on the second turn and was not a threat.
