UNUSUALLY HOT chased along the inside down the backstretch, swung out into the drive, but lacked a rally when asked down the lane. NO KA OI was outrun down the backstretch and on the turn, swung out into the middle of the track for the stretch drive, but failed to mount a rally. THREAT was hustled early to press the early leader, continued in contention on the turn, but fell back in the stretch drive. DUMAANI'S GOLD was outrun throughout and without a rally in the stretch drive.

GOOD GUY pulled his way along to prompt the pace three deep then between foes on the turn, fought back between horses and was in a bit tight in midstretch and held third. BARACHO a bit slow to begin, settled toward the inside then moved up between foes, continued off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and bested the others. T. W. 'S TANK hopped slightly at the start, chased between horses then just off the rail, continued inside on the turn, went around a foe into the stretch and lacked a rally. DELTAMAX close up stalking the pace inside, was in a bit tight into the turn, came out leaving the bend and into the stretch and weakened. SILVERADO GOLD chased inside then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. A PINT FOR MARY settled outside a rival, split horses into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. LITTLE STREET CAT angled in and dueled inside, dropped back leaving the turn and weakened. WHOSONTOP allowed to settle outside then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun.
