FRANTIC CITY pressed the pace from the rail, was squeezed back a bit at the turn, chased to the stretch then finished all out inside. UPMARKET GIRL took the lead midbackstretch and sprinted clear, was engaged late turn and quickly headed then chased gamely to the end. DELI LAMA, rated off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. MIDNIGHT CRUSH, in touch between foes, was hustled from two to five-wide on the turn and finished determinedly. MAGIC TUNE showed brief speed but dropped back, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but failed to threaten. HONEYMOON SUITE had early speed, was headed midbackstretch, chased on the turn but was losing the battle to stay close and tired at the top of the stretch.

MARSHALL ROOSTER, close late backstretch, was squeezed back at the turn, chased to the end but was unable to gain late. GOLDEN HALL was hustled from off the pace, angled from six-wide to two-wide through the turn and finished gamely in vain. SEEKING THE CODE chased from the middle of the pack, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the turn then finished evenly. DURLINGVILLE was hustled from off the pace, angled from the fifth path to two-wide on the turn then finished all out inside. C'MON MAN chased two and three-wide but evened out in the late stages. MONTADOR chased from between rivals, came five-wide into the stretch then flattened out. ASHFORD VALLEY was hustled from off the pace along the rail but never reached contention.

REBECCA'S SONG pressed from the outside, dueled five-wide on the turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch but gave way grudgingly. MAGIC BROOMSTICK raced midpack between foes, stalked the duel on the turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch but took quick advantage of an opening upper stretch and rallied gamely. DUBAI CALLING raced midpack outside, angled from four to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. STREET GOLD raced midpack between horses, angled two to four-wide on the turn, angled out again in the stretch and tendered a mild late run. MUSICAL HEART settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. SNOW PATCHES forced the pace, dueled four-wide on the turn then gave way at the top of the stretch. SCARLET PLUME closed along the rail, bid into the turn, backed away a bit and stalked the leaders, chased into the stretch but had no response when asked. WEEKEND PROSPECT showed speed, was joined at the turn, dueled three-deep then tired at the top of the stretch.
