VICAR STREET, in touch, angled three to five-wide through the far turn, was all out in the stretch and just missed. WALDHEIM led from early backstretch, quickened late turn then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. BIG TIME broke a step slowly, raced off the pace, rallied six-wide and finished gamely in vain. SPIRIT FLYING broke in the air, raced well back, was hustled on the far turn then evened out late inside. LARVIN forced the issue on the backstretch, came three and four-wide through the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. PERSONAL SIGNAL led briefly, was headed entering the backstretch, forced the issue from the rail, gave way on the far turn then tired in the stretch.

SPIRIT LODGE led early, set a pressured pace, was hustled late turn then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. FLIP FOR THE COIN was taken back early, raced off the pace, closed on the far turn and finished determinedly. PIRATE'S LEGEND stalked the pace three-wide and finished under an all out drive. T. T.'S POINT settled off the pace, began to lose between rivals and was steadied midway of the far turn then tendered a mild rally outside. QUINZEE, in touch, chased hard on the far turn, was all out in the stretch and flattened out late. SAY NO EVIL raced midpack, came four and five-wide through the turn then evened out in the stretch. DIPLOMATIC IMPACT raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. FULL OF WISDOM raced off the pace, came five and six-wide through the far turn then lacked a rally.

D'S LEGEND STORM showed speed, was headed and forced the pace, moved up late backstretch and dueled through the turn, gained the lead at the top of the stretch and held sway, driving. SHADES OF GOLD, in touch, closed on the backstretch, chased late turn, loomed dangerously upper stretch but couldn't stay close. COLOROFSPEED, in touch outside, raced four and five-wide on the turn and finished determinedly. PADRAIG raced midpack, closed six-wide late turn and finished gamely. JOEY'S BEST broke poorly giving his rivals a long advantage, closed outside horses on the turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied. BEIHAI PARK raced midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn, angled out through the stretch under a game drive. TAKE A PITCH raced off the pace, was hustled angling from two to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. HAMEISH raced off the pace, was hustled hard two-wide through the turn then evened out late. BULLET BOY raced midpack, angled from three-wide to the rail late turn but lacked a strong closing response. QUIET MOON led onto the main track, dueled on the turn, gave way at the top of the stretch and tired. TRAJECTAMAX, in touch between horses, chased late turn and was in striking range but tired a furlong out. RAGING INFERNO stalked early, began to fade late backstretch and tired.
