PAY IN KIND was outrun early, circled five wide entering the stretch and close steadily in the middle of the track to get up in the late stages. MY GOLDEN OPINION steadied along the rail at the half mile pole, saved ground on the turn, raced in traffic while lacking room in upper stretch, split horses in midstretch and finished willingly. OUR HONOR set the pace on the rail into midstretch and weakened. SAINT DAIMON steadied sharply at the half mile pole, lodged an outside bit at the quarter pole and weakened in the final eighth. BASE COMMANDER pressed three wide into midstretch and tired. ELTISH STAR failed to mount a serious rally. SAMHOON checked early, advanced six wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. SENECA SUMMER stumbled at the start, steadied in traffic at the half mile pole and failed to seriously threaten thereafter.

SMAX chased the winner three wide, and flattened out. MUGGER HUGGER raced five wide to the turn and lacked a late response. BAD BOY LUKE pressed the winner on the rail and tired in upper stretch. NEW YORK BOBBY steadied between horses on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. EIGHTOHSEVENMAIN stumbled at the start, raced up close between horses and gave way on the turn.
