KNOWN GAMBLER saved ground early, swung out on the turn and lacked a late response. LLOYDOBLER pressed the winner in the two path and tired. FRESHMAN DORM failed to threaten while three wide. ARRR PIRATES BOOTY checked slightly at the start and never reached contention. UPPER AFLEET was never close.
