SIDING lost footing slightly start, chased the leader early, moved up to contest the pace through the turn, dueled through most of the stretch, outfinished. HIGH BROW HONEY moved out to be four wide backstretch, bit rank, continued four wide through the turn, set down for the drive, finished up willingly to close the gap on the top two. IROQUOIS MISS bobbled at the start, turned in an even effort off the inside. MS LEXI LU lacked speed while racing off the inside, made little impact. SHADYS BACK broke alertly, got clear soon after, set or forced the pace through the bend toward the inside, weakened in the drive. WILDPLAY retreated.

STREAK OF THUNDER closest to the leader while off the inside and in hand, engaged that foe nearing the furlong marker, wore down rival, shook clear, lasted. DABOSSMAN void of early foot, asked for some turn turning for home, split foes soon after, angled out a bit when rallying late, finished well to be getting to the winner. REGIONS REWARD broke on top, soon got clear, set the pace in hand, continued to show the way into the lane, faltered in the late going. BIRD STORM lacked early foot, came five wide into the stretch, drifted stretch, finished up evenly. POPLAR HOUSE allowed to settle off the pace and the inside, failed to respond when asked in the drive. DOUBLE JUMP within striking distance three wide, tired from those early efforts. THATTLEAVEAMARK also had nothing for the drive. MIZZEN MAZE four wide through the first turn, finished far back.

TRIPSTAR off the pace, came four wide out of the turn when beginning to rally, up late for the show. GO GO CAT well off the early pace, steadied slightly when improving position along the rail turning for home, displayed a modest amount of late interest while continuing along the inside. BUTTON BOX KID bumped at the start, raced within striking distance three path, flattened out a bit in the late going. SNUCK IN THE DANCE three wide into the turn, four wide exiting the bend, managed little in the way of a rally. VENDREDI LE TREIZE angled out to be five wide turning for home, failed to rally. PICTURE LA TEE bumped start, last away, well back, improved position down the lane by passing tiring foes. LEALLAH'S ANTHONY forwardly placed, tired while five wide out of the turn.
