CLOSING STEPS pulled her way to the lead in the run to the first turn, was well rated down the backstretch and around the turn, responded to urging while on the inside through the lane and held her rivals safe. CORACAO BEIJO chased outside a rival down the backstretch then off the rail around the turn, entered the stretch three wide, rallied in the final furlong to narrow the gap and hold the place. SUPER SOPHIE was outrun down the backstretch, chased outside a rival into the second turn, swung out for the drive and rallied to gain the show in the late stages. FEED A FEVER chased the leaders from the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, angled off the rail for the drive but lacked the needed rally in the final furlong. WHISPERING DIXIE was outrun down the backstretch, chased inside a rival into the second turn, remained inside for the drive but lacked a bid though the lane. ARGENTA crossed over to stalk the pacesetter into the first turn, moved closer on the backstretch, remained in contention to the top of the lane and fell back in the stretch drive.

ORIENTATION HALL stalked the early pace outside then bid alongside the runner-up, dueled for the lead, put a head in front on the turn, fought back under urging through a long drive and held on gamely between foes late. BILO sped to the early lead, dueled along the inside throughout, fought back gamely through the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. A CAT NAMED SNIPE chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and finished with interest outside the top pair. POLISH QUEST broke slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch, came off the rail on the turn, angled out into the stretch and was outfinished. SEA RASCAL a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued off the inside on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JANS HEADLIGHT between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, angled in and fell back some on the turn and weakened.

RED ALERT DAY (GB) pulled his way along to stalk off the rail early, bid outside a rival then three deep a half mile out, battled alongside the winner on the second turn and through much of the stretch and just held second. GREAT SIEGE (IRE) chased inside, went around a rival into the second turn, came out into the stretch and just missed the place. PRINCE REXY (AUS) between horses early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, moved up outside into the second turn, angled inward in deep stretch and was edged for third. STAR NICHOLAS threw his head a bit at the start, settled inside, went around the early leader on the second turn and lacked the needed late rally. CANDY PULL tugged his way to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled briefly on the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.

WARRENS CASINO GUY settled between horses then outside a rival chasing the pace, dropped back in the stretch, was pulled up when lame in midstretch and vanned off.

FLOATING HEART angled in and settled outside a rival, found the rail on the backstretch, came out into some traffic on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well. UNRIVALED BELLE stalked inside then came out into the first turn, tracked the pace just off the rail, split foes three deep into the second turn, continued off the inside leaving that turn and could not offer the necessary late kick. FREEDOM STAR had speed off the rail then angled in, set the pace inside, inched away into the second turn, came out into the stretch, battled outside a rival in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. DREAM EMPRESS allowed to settle off the pace inside, saved ground throughout and improved position in the stretch. STARDOM BOUND unhurried outside early, settled three deep, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PRETTY KATHERINE chased between horses, continued off the inside leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MISS SILVER BROOK stalked three deep then outside, went four wide into the second turn and again into the stretch and weakened. SPIRIT SEEKER angled in and prompted the pace outside a rival, stalked between foes into the second turn, dropped back in a bit tight midway on that turn and weakened. GUMPTION was in a good position chasing the pace between horses or outside a rival, also dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
