TRANQUIL SONG rushed up along the rail to gain a clear early advantage, dug in when challenged in midstretch, fought gamely under strong right hand urging and prevailed after a hard drive. VICTORIA LYNN was in hand along the rail, angled out on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch, fought heads apart into deep stretch and was outfinished by the winner. LADY WHIMSICAL stalked three wide into upper stretch and tired. SPIRITUAL TUNE pressed along the inside and dropped back badly on the turn. ALLA PRIMA swung four wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. WARRIOR SPIRIT dropped back early after breaking a bit slowly and was never close thereafter.

DECORATED COURT checked slightly while saving ground on the backstretch, angled out while gaining at the quarter pole, surged to the front inside the furlong marker and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the final strides. BOBS PINUP GIRL was outrun early, saved ground while gaining on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed steadily but could not get up. SUN SHOWER pressed the pace in the two path, gained a slim lead in upper stretch and yielded late. EAST COASTER checked slightly in traffic on the turn, angled out and rallied belatedly. FOURTH CHAPTER was outrun for a half, rapidly gained five wide outside the winner to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. CITY SPIRIT set the pace on the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way. NORMANDY QUEEN was never a factor. FAGEDABOUDIT GAL chased four wide and faltered on the far turn. RUN FOR SHELTER raced up close for a half and tired.
