NOLITE TIMERE was reserved early in the two path, moved out on the backstretch, made steady progress on the far turn, rallied three wide leaving the turn, charged to the front in midstretch and drew away under right hand urging. PATENT PENDING TOM trailed to the far turn, circled four wide while gaining a bit on the turn and closed well from outside to wear down CRAZY CHARLIE for the place. CRAZY CHARLIE settled just off the pace, rallied just inside the winner to threaten on the turn and weakened in deep stretch. SIR CRYPTOMITE was outrun to the turn and passed mostly tiring horses. ISLAND SON was hustled up to gain the early advantage, led to the top of the stretch and gave way. EDDIE'S POINT pressed the pace on the rail for five furlongs and tired. NO BLOVIATING never reached contention. KICK UP YOUR HEELS raced in midpack between horses and gave way on the far turn.

SNEAKY GIRL trailed after breaking a bit slowly, waited briefly while saving ground nearing the quarter pole, angled out in upper stretch, made a run in midstretch but was no match for the winner. DANA'S BELL rushed up from outside, pressed the winner for a half and steadily tired thereafter. CINDERELLA'S WISH showed only brief speed. PUDDY DE LUCA checked at the start, drifted wide while gaining at the quarter pole and flattened out.

FUZZY'S STORY set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and gave way. LOOPY DE LOOP stumbled at the start and was never close thereafter. I'M HOOKED UP saved ground in midpack leaving the turn and lacked a late response. TURNPIKE TOKEN chased three wide for a half and steadily tired thereafter. DRIVEN BY ROYAL was outrun after breaking slowly.
