RADIO RELAY pressed the pace along the rail, gained a slim lead from TIGER D. R. in early stretch, then edged away from that rival under pressure. TIGER D. R. set the pace under pressure off the rail, responded when headed by RADIO RELAY but couldn't stay with rival while holding the place. BERNULLI chased the leaders into the stretch and weakened. TREKKIE unhurried early, saved ground and passed tired rivals. DEALING LUCKY chased the pace three wide around the turn, then gave way while drifting out through the stretch run. BULLARIUM failed to menace. VANDERKAAY stumbled and bumped between rivals at the start, was never a threat. RAYO DE LUZ showed early foot and tired. LETTERMAN'S HUMOR rated in striking position off the pace, faltered leaving the turn. MASCOT bumped with VANDERKAAY at the start, raced three wide and faded. BRUSH AWAY was done early after bumping with VANDERKAAY at the start, then was pulled up in the stretch and vanned off.

OMEGA THREE PETE stalked the pace three wide, rallied to catch SNOW MON just inside the eighth pole, then drew clear. NOTE TO HARRY steadied in behind the leader on the first turn, stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. WONDER'S SENSATION tracked the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while closing to just miss the place. SNOW MON set the pace along the rail, repulsed STARSHIP VOYAGE when headed by that rival on the backstretch, continued to make the pace along the rail to the eighth pole, then gave way. NOT FOR GOLD reserved off the pace, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but had no late response. BOLD IMAGE off slowly, failed to menace. VARITEK rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. KEAL saved ground to no avail. BLUES BROTHER was outrun. WISE WARRIOR was not a factor. STARSHIP VOYAGE chased the pace, moved to gain a brief lead racing down the backstretch, then couldn't stay with SNOW MON and faltered in the drive. EXCALIBUR raced three wide and faded.
