ONE SHOT (ARG) went straight to the early lead into the first turn, opened a clear advantage around the turn and into the backstretch, was challenged for command on the second turn, repulsed all bids through the lane to post a game decision. JUST HEAT chased outside a rival down the backstretch, moved up on the turn to enter the stretch three wide, rallied through the drive to gain second on the wire. EXILE crossed over to stalk the winner into the first turn, moved closer down the backstretch, bid for command on the second turn, but was unable to catch the leader in the final furlong while losing second late. STREETS OF HEAVEN chased inside a rival down the backstretch, saved some ground on the second turn, remained inside through the drive and could not mount a sufficient rally. TIZ AFIRE was outrun to the lane and lacked a rally in the final furlong. SHELTER ISLAND chased from the outside down the backstretch, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and could not gain on the leaders.

Footnotes

BORN TO SHOP stumbled leaving the gate but quickly recovered and sped to the front, set the pace, drifted out bit exiting the turn then gamely held off inside rival under urging. UKANDOIT stalked while outside foe, prompted the pace around the turn, was blocked behind pacesetter entering the lane, shifted inward and went willingly to the wire from along the rail. PLAYING FOR KEEPS was off bit slow, rushed up inside, chased along the rail, came off the fence and rallied on two wide path late to gain show. DEL MAR DANGER settled outside, chased three wide into turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved placing from the outside. SCRUTINIZING KAT forwardly placed early, chased from off the fence, came three deep into the lane and finished evenly. WILLIS was void of any early foot, angled in, secured the inside, hugged the rail into the lane and improved placing. GRATO stalked three then four wide into the stretch and weakened from between horses in the drive. HIGH HILL STAR bumped leaving the gate, settled slightly off the rail, chased on two wide path and failed to threaten. HARBOR MARKER settled off the pace, chased three wide and between foes, dropped back around the bend and weakened. DR. TONG bumped at the start, moved up inside to force the pace, lost contact on the turn and gave way inside. The rider of UKANDOTI claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference in the upper stretch but the stewards disallowed the foul claim, ruling the incident did not alter the original order of finish.

NITRO ACTIVE settled along the rail, angled off the fence nearing second turn, moved up between then three wide into the lane, shifted back inward, rallied inside and outfinished outside rivals. CAVANAL settled off the pace while coming out some, chased three wide, moved up four then five wide into the stretch, reached front in midstretch but was out gamed to the wire from the outside. JOURNEYMAN crossed over and tracked the pacesetter into backstretch, whittled gap on leader, moved alongside then gained slim lead nearing the stretch, was overtaken in the drive then battled gamely from between foes to the wire. MIND THE MINISTER chased off the rail or outside foe to second bend, moved up three deep then four wide and outside winner into the stretch and chased top trio home. BRIGHT PREDICTION unhurried while angling over, saved ground into the stretch, came off the rail but failed to menace. BONJOUR (NZ) crossed over early, chased from along the fence, continued inside, in tight and steadied in midstretch, came off the rail and never recovered. POLONIUS stepped to the front and padded lead, set pace with clear cushion on the backstretch, was overtaken nearing the stretch and weakened inside.

THIS TIME BABY dueled then gained slim advantage from the inside, slightly padded that cushion in the lane, continued slightly off the fence and determinedly held. FAIR KISSES stalked on two wide path and outside foe, advanced three wide on the final bend, was floated out in upper stretch until past the eighth marker, came back in, rallied strongly late and just missed from outside winner. MULTIPLYINGTHEHEAT angled over the to rail early, moved up inside to second turn, between horses into the lane, came out some in the drive and gamely gained third. WARRENS MATCHMAKER caught four wide into initial turn, gradually worked her way to the rail, advanced inside, loomed inside winner entering the stretch but was outfinished. L'ENCHANTERESSE (IRE) contested the early issue then conceded lead to rival, stalked on two wide path, lugged out badly in upper stretch to past midstretch and lost placing. BARD'S DAY reserved off the pace while angling over, chased outside foe, remained on same path to the lane and was no threat. NOTWITHSTANDING five wide early, angled in some, advanced from off the rail on the second bend, caught five wide into the stretch and failed to menace. MACHO MISS stalked from slightly off the rail, shifted for wide leaving the final turn and weakened. HARVEY'SHALLOFFAME crossed over early while taken well off the pace, chased inside and was outrun throughout.
