LASER POINT went straight to the lead on the inside into the first turn, maintained a measured advantage to the top of the lane when challenged and held on through the drive under left handed urging. JAMES PRIOR stalked the pacesetter from the outside down the backstretch, was asked for his best to nearly reach even terms with the leader at the top of the lane and was unable to pass that one while clearly second best. FENICE (IRE) broke out slightly, was under restraint while chasing on the inside down the backstretch and was unable to make up the needed ground in the final furlong. CAUSE chased outside a rival down the backstretch, began to weaken on the second turn and fell back in the stretch drive.

GOLD ALY grabbed command shortly after the break, rated from the inside then bit off the fence, inched away on second turn, padded that margin in upper stretch then safely held. MEGASTAR reserved while slightly off the rail, chased on two then three wide path to the stretch, rallied and was along for the place. MILYONE tugged his way up to prompt pace into backstretch, gained rail, moved up some, bit tight nearing second turn, dropped back and went evenly inside late. B'S LUCKY STRIKE moved up from off the fence, forced pace early on the backstretch, lost contact around last bend and weakened from between horses. ROAD TO THE THRONE settled off the pace, angled over some, chased two wide, secured the fence leaving the backstretch, continued inside and did not menace. STARCATTER reserved early, also came in some, chased outside rival then between foes, came three wide into the lane and lacked any rally. EL VINO unhurried early, chased along the rail or just off the fence and failed to reach contention. BARTOK'S BANKER shifted over early, chased from along the rail, remained inside to the lane and weakened.

CANDY ARCHES quickly sprinted to the front, dictated pace while along the rail then slightly off the fence, came in slightly in upper stretch, dug in through the drive and determinedly lasted. GENERAL DAN outsprinted into first turn, stalked from along the rail to the stretch, moved up bit, lacked room then shifted out, closed gap in deep stretch but was denied from outside winner. SOUVENIR SLEW settled off the pace and off the rail, chased three wide around both turns, came out some in the drive and finished very willingly. CADEAUX DU MONDE (GB) outside runner-up tracking the pacesetter, continued on same path into stretch, came out bit in the drive and weakened late. SONIC WEST content to lag back from the inside, saved ground to the stretch, came out some but was outrun throughout.

HOCKLEY forced the early issue from the inside, moved up along the rail, gained advantage leaving the backstretch, shook free exiting the last bend and safely held. ROYAL F J three deep into first turn, stalked from off the rail, remained on same path into the lane and finished strongly. JUNIPER PASS angled over into initial turn, chased on two wide path, shifted out nearing eighth marker and bested others. DISTORTED ECONOMY unhurried inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, lacked room inside nearing midstretch, angled out and gained minor award. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) settled from between rivals, chased two then three wide into the stretch and lacked needed late punch. SEIZE POWER was off bit slow, angled ver, chased outside rival, continued on two wide path and failed to reach contention. ONE FRENCH KISS forwardly placed from along the fence, remained inside, came out in upper stretch and weakened bit from between horses. GALESVILLE hesitated leaving the gate to be off well behind the field, trailed inside, swung out into the lane and was no factor. BODY BUILDER reserved from the inside, chased two then three wide to the stretch, angled out further and failed to menace from the far outside. BIG WAGS stepped to the front, set early pace from slightly off the rail, lost control into second bend, forced issue around that bend then gave way inside.

MONITOR PASS chased from the inside, continued to hug the rail into the stretch and went evenly to the wire. last turn and never menaced. LINDA'S POSSE three wide early then between horses, angled in bit, trailed, came out some late and was no threat. EDENISE forwardly placed early, stalked from between rivals, dropped back nearing midstretch and gave way late.
