CHIPPEWA COURT was under a firm hold along the rail through the opening quarter, moved out on the far turn, advanced three wide into the stretch and finished willingly from outside but couldn't run down the winner. GATTINARA steadied in traffic early, saved ground on the turn and improved her position. CALLING MY COLORS dueled inside the winner into midstretch and weakened. MAMA BROWN raced just off the pace in the two path and lacked a late response. SPUNKY saved ground to no avail. DIVORCE COURT trailed throughout.

GOODDAY was reserved just off the early pace, gained three wide at the quarter pole then kicked in late in the middle of the track but could not get up. NOT A PEEP rushed up quickly in hand, set a pressured pace along the rail into midstretch and weakened in the final seventy yards. DOREMIFASOLLATIDO pressed in the two path, lodged a mild bid at the quarter pole and flattened out. ANJORIE trailed throughout.

MCVICTORY stalked three wide on the backstretch, waited briefly for room while saving ground on the turn, shot through on the rail to take the lead in upper stretch, shook loose in midstretch and drew away under good handling. PERSISTENTLY was outrun for a half while saving ground, split horses while advancing on the turn then closed mildly to narrowly gain the place. CLASSOFSIXTYTHREE was outrun for a half, gained four wide nearing the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. DANA'S BELL set the pace on the rail, opened a clear lead on the turn and faltered. LESLY'S BACK raced in midpack between horses for six furlongs and lacked a late response. SISTER'S SPEED moved out early, pressed in the two path then drifted out while tiring at the top of the stretch.

FRANKLIN DELANO was reserved in the middle of the pack, made a steady four wide move into the far turn, took the lead at the quarter pole and edged away under steady urging. GILT EDGED raced just inside the winner for a half, rallied between horses to challenge on the turn, fought into midstretch and held well to best the others. RUNAWAY LEGEND was outrun for a half, checked outside the spill on the far turn, swung four wide and rallied mildly. GIVE IT BACK sprinted clear, set the pace inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. PINK FREUD bobbled at the start, trailed for a half, checked and moved out on the far turn and failed to threaten. MAXIMUS PROSPECTOR pressed the pace from outside and gave way leaving the backstretch. MOUNT KARAKORUM was reserved between horses, fell over a fallen rival on the far turn unseating the rider in the process. LONG CON saved ground just off the pace, clipped heels along the inside and fell at the three-eighths pole. Following a stewards inquiry into the incident there was no change in the order of finish.
