SNUGGS AND KISSES alternated for the lead along the inside and held on gamely. BEAUTIFUL SONG forwardly placed while off the inside, angled out five wide late on the second turn but lacked the needed closing bid. SPLASHDOWN within striking distance off the rail, angled out and moved to a forward position four wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. SILVER LA BELLE close up three wide, held on well to the stretch and gave way. ROYAL SEPTOR alternated for the lead off the inside, dropped back and gained the inside on the second turn but faded.
