LOU BRISSIE broke slowly, moved into contention along the outside leaving the chute, had his jockey lose the whip near the five-sixteenths marker, came three wide into the stretch, angled out with a furlong to run, finished with a surge and caught NO MORE YOGI'S in the final yards. NO MORE YOGI'S broke sharply and sprinted clear to set the pace, widened his advantage entering the lane, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. TOY chased the pace four wide, weakened during the drive but had enough left to just hold the show. SIR SHAUN was shuffled back between rivals leaving the chute, made a late rally three wide between horses and improved his position. MATT'S MAMMAJAMMER was allowed to settle, swung to the outside leaving the turn and finished with a belated gain. CHIPSHOT broke slowly, moved up along the inside through the turn, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out.

SETTLING SEAS tugged to the fore, angled in and controlled the tempo under a tight hold, was well handled and gamely led throughout. MAESTRO MISS broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride along the inside, shifted out to commence her bid with three furlongs to run, circled four wide and was all out to earn the place. MY LADY A. P. settled saving ground, moved into striking distance through the second turn, drifted out a bit entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MESA ROSE was allowed to settle, closed the gap off of the inside entering the second turn, waited in traffic nearing the quarter pole, altered course to the outside with three-sixteenths to run and finished with a belated gain once clear. TAKE A VOW settled in hand three deep, offered a mild bid nearing the quarter pole, but faltered between rivals with a furlong to run and faded. JUDYINLIGHTS was forwardly placed three wide for six furlongs and dropped out.

PARIOLI'S TRICK settled in hand and was reserved off of the pace, wheeled to the outside entering the stretch, made a steady advance and wore down the leaders in the final strides. T. D. VANCE was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance through the turn, angled out for a clear path with three-sixteenths to run, finished well but was unable to match strides with the winner. KATOLAK COWBOY disputed the pace between horses through the opening quarter, then along the inside through the turn, kicked clear entering the stretch, but faltered inside the sixteenth marker and had just enough left to hold the show. CONNECTIONS broke in the air and was away well behind his field, settled at the back under a snug hold, angled out entering the stretch, closed willingly and was making up ground with every stride. CASPIAN was away alertly, settled off of the pace four wide, offered a mild bid three deep leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. TRULY AMAZING was forwardly placed along the inside, checked near the seven-sixteenths marker losing position, checked sharply inside the three-eighths pole, came up empty entering the stretch and retreated. SPECTACULAR KID pressed the pace between horses three wide for a half and dropped out.

The latter settled in hand, wheeled to the outside leaving the turn to launch a bold bid, came five wide and was getting to the winner steadily. GO LYDIA GO was hustled along three wide, stayed on well through a prolonged drive but wasn't quite good enough. COURTLY MISS was slow into stride, angled out six wide to make a late rally and improved her position through the stretch. APPLE PANDOWDY was forwardly placed between horses, angled to the inside entering the stretch to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the effort. EXECUTIVE SWEET stalked the pace three deep, loomed a danger entering the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong. ELLIDAY pressed the pace along the inside to the stretch and tired. BELLAFINA saved ground to no avail. NOT ME BUT U broke in the air, was away well behind her field and never recovered.

HARLAN'S PRINCESS was allowed to settle, angled out to launch her bid circling five wide, finished with a rush and was up in the final yards. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER attended the pace along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, struck the front with a sixteenth to run, kept on well but was denied late. SPARKLE OF LIGHT contested the pace between horses through the turn, then along the inside entering the stretch, was bumped when HOW ABOUT ALEXIS was forced in with a furlong to run, but stayed on well to hold the show. JAZZ DANCER made a steady advance circling five wide, poked her head in front nearing the eighth pole, drifted in under right handed urging, bumped HOW ABOUT ALEXIS repeatedly and weakened during the drive. HOW ABOUT ALEXIS chased the pace three wide, drew even leaving the turn, disputed the issue to the final furlong, was jostled between horses when JAZZ DANCER came in and faltered thereafter. ACADEMY ALLIE contended between horses to the stretch and tired. CHURCH MOUSE showed little. EXTREEM QUALITY rushed up along the inside to contest the pace, but was used up before going a half and dropped out. JUNEY BIRD was outrun. Following a Stewards inquiry into the stretch run, JAZZ DANCER was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth for drifting in and bumping HOW ABOUT ALEXIS near the eighth pole.
