RUINATION sped to the early lead from the outset, maintained a clear advantage to the top of the lane and drew away from her foes in the final furlong. SILVER HEAT stalked the pacesetter in good position down the backstretch, pulled her way forward on the inside into the second turn, saved ground, angled out for the drive and was no threat to the winner while clearly second best. WARREN'S ROYAL MOM stalked outside a rival down the backstretch, moved up to be three wide on the second turn and was unable to gain the needed ground in the stretch. LISA LULU was outrun to the lane and failed to mount a serious rally in the final furlong. TRAIL BEYOND stalked the pacesetter down the backstretch, was between foes on the second turn and fell back though the stretch drive. WARREN'S JOSEPHINE chased inside the entire journey and was unable to gain any ground in the lane.

MENSA HEAT stalked three deep on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch, rallied to the front under urging a sixteenth out and won clear. DON'T ANSWER had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away into the turn, angled in, fought back past midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but was clearly second best. STRAY CAT settled inside then just off the rail, came out on the turn and into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and edged foes for third three deep on the line. INTOTHEWILD pulled his way up inside to press the pace, came out a bit off the heels of the leader early on the turn, continued between horses in the stretch and was edged for the show. D C TAPIT also tugged his way along inside to stalk the pace, continued on the rail throughout and lacked the needed late kick. FREE LUNCH between foes early, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. NATIONAL HOLIDAY chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, continued between foes in the drive and weakened late.

KRIS SILVER pulled a bit and stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, fought back between horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. YODELEN DAN saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished with interest four wide on the line. NITRO ACTIVE sent to the early lead, set the pace inside while pulling a bit under a rating hold, fought back along the fence on the second turn and through the stretch and continued willingly to the end. SPURRIER settled outside a rival then chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was outfinished.
