BONNIE BLUE FLAG sped to the early lead into the first turn, remained clear down the backstretch, increased her advantage on the second turn, drifted out at the furlong marker and held her foes safe to the wire. CAITIE'S SECRET stalked the pacesetter from the outside to the stretch, lost some ground at the top of the lane, challenged inside the winner in the final furlong and was a clear second at the wire. NICOLE H had no early speed, moved up between horses on the second turn, entered the stretch three wide but lost her punch in the lane while being outfinished for second. TIZ SMOKE TIZ FIRE bobbled a stride out of the gate, chased inside down the backstretch, remained on the wood on the second turn and through the stretch drive and had no impact in the final furlong. KAYSA DEEYA stalked in a good position down the backstretch, entered the lane four wide and could not make up any ground in the final furlong.

SOUTHERN FIREBALL had good early speed off the rail then stalked just off the inside, took the lead between horses into the stretch, inched away under urging in midstretch and held gamely toward the inside. ELUSIVE GALAXY (IRE) chased three deep then off the fence, bid three wide into the stretch and continued willingly but could not catch the winner. GHOST GIRL broke inward and a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and edged a foe for the show. SWEET HANNI between horses early, settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was edged for third. SWEET SOPHIA went up inside to the early lead, inched away and set the pace along the rail but weakened in the stretch. Rail on hill at zero.

TIS four wide into the first turn, chased outside then off the rail, moved up four wide on the second turn and into the stretch to take the lead, inched away under urging and held. DUKE OF ASPEN chased off the rail then between foes, angled in leaving the second turn, came out for room in midstretch, split horses twice in the final furlong and got up for the place. B. I. GUY a step slow to begin, settled inside stalking the pace, was in a bit tight midway on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and got up three wide late for third. TALE OF THE BAT between horses early, chased outside a rival then three deep, bid three wide into the stretch, drifted in some in the drive and was outfinished for a minor award. ROOS ON THE LOOSE dueled outside a rival, battled between foes leaving the second turn and into the stretch, drifted inward in midstretch and weakened. GRAN PETER saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARRENS TEMPTATION four wide early, stalked off the rail, continued outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. K K'S BRO (MEX) dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied in tight in midstretch and also weakened.

CLOSE TO THE EDGE a bit awkwardly into stride, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, made the lead outside foes nearing the sixteenth pole, then drifted in and inched away late under some left handed urging and strong handling. APRIORITY had speed off the rail then prompted the pace outside a rival, bid again leaving the turn, was between horses in midstretch, drifted in past the eighth pole then was in tight behind the winner nearing the wire. DERRICK DO broke in a bit, pulled his way between horses then dueled inside, inched away briefly into the turn, fought back along the rail leaving the turn and in the stretch, came out slightly past the eighth pole, continued inside and held the show. SAND SEAS settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. TRAVEL SQUAD unhurried inside then just off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. BRACE YOURSELVES went up inside to stalk the pace, came out a bit into the stretch, steadied in tight quarters past the eight pole to fall back and lacked a further response. TITUS AURELIUS (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace three deep on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and also weakened. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incidents in the stretch but made no change when they ruled the rider of BRACE YOURSELVES overreacted to tight quarters in midstretch and the close quarters between the top pair late did not alter the original order of finish.

FREE FLYING SOUL chased off the rail, angled in on the turn, rallied along the fence in the stretch to gain a short lead late but was caught. ALPHA KITTEN chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, rallied between horses in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. HALLELUJAH TRAIL had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail in the stretch and held on well but was caught between foes late. MISS MCCALL dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. GILDED GEM dropped back outside then angled in a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHE'S CHEEKY settled inside then outside a rival into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response.

FULL ON squeezed a bit at the start, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CARBON HOOFPRIINT (GB) between foes early, moved up three deep to duel for the lead, stalked outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. HIGH TIDE RISING chased off the rail then between foes into the turn, continued off the inside, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. TOM BOMBADIL settled outside then four wide, dropped back off the rail on the turn, drifted five wide into the stretch then drifted in through the drive and was not a threat.
