IDA OF MARCH was outrun down the backstretch, moved up between horses on the turn, entered the stretch three wide, came in slightly at the furlong marker and was up to take a desperate decision on the wire. GLORIFIED PRINCESS chased inside on the turn, angled off the rail at the head of the lane, was between foes in the final furlong and just missed at the wire. MISS OLIVIA K sped to the lead on the inside, held a clear advantage into the lane, battled inside to deep stretch and was outfinished in the final yards while a clear third. BRIANNA MARIE prompted the pace from the outside to the quarter pole and fell back in the stretch drive. THE WOMEN'S DIVA broke in at the start to be off a bit slowly, stalked in a good position down the backstretch, began to lose ground on the turn, entered the stretch four wide and gave way in the middle of the track.

PACK YOUR BAGS had speed outside a rival then stalked just off the rail bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch and wore down that one late under urging. CRASH LANDING dueled inside the winner then inched away on the backstretch, set the pace along the fence, held on well in the drive but was worn down late. SEA RASCAL between foes early, chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and got up for third three deep on the line. ONE VOTE four wide early, chased alongside a foe then three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show between horses late. STORMY GAME a bit slow into stride, went up between horses then stalked off the rail, angled in nearing the turn, continued along the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SCOTTY JONES saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally.

TIMEZONE chased outside then split horses three deep leaving the hill, came four wide into the stretch and rallied while lugging in, bid three wide in deep stretch to gain the lead and proved best under good handling. SO NICE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail on the hill, drifted out a bit and brushed with a rival in upper stretch, drifted in some in late stretch and held on to deep stretch but could not contain the winner. MAGIC LANTERN (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, split horses in midstretch, bid inside past midstretch was in a bit close a sixteenth out and bested the others. COME HOME QUICK stalked outside then three deep on the hill and into the stretch, brushed with the runner-up in upper stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. MISINJENNUOUS pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, was in a bit tight past the eighth pole and weakened. TEQUILA TONIGHT settled inside then off the rail, swung out into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. SWEETLY dropped back outside then off the rail, went up four wide leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. ANATOLIAN BEAUTY dueled outside the runner-up then stalked between horses, continued alongside a rival into the stretch, found the inside in the drive and weakened. MUIRNEEN pulled her way between horses to chase the pace, continued between foes on the hill and also weakened in the stretch. Rail on hill at 14 feet.

WARREN'S CONCEPT saved ground stalking the pace throughout and was clearly second best. FALAISE POCKET chased outside then alongside a rival, angled to the inside into the stretch and bested the others. ALITTLEBITAJUSTICE came in and steadied just after the start, settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MICHAELS JILA had speed between horses then stalked between foes, came out three deep into the stretch and weakened. DUTY BEFORE HONOR broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail to the stretch and did not rally. HIGH HILL STAR was in a good position chasing the pace outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. RED ON SUNDAY had speed three deep then dueled outside the winner, stalked off the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch.

DANCE MARINO pulled his way between horses then stalked outside, continued off the rail on the turn, bid three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, battled outside foes in midstretch and between horses in deep stretch and just held third. FUN AND FROLIC dueled outside a rival then between horses while being floated out a bit into the stretch, put a head in front between foes, fought back through the final furlong and was edged for third. UNUSUALLY LUCKY had speed between foes then dueled a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out into the stretch, fought back off the rail in the drive then between foes late and was narrowly edged for a minor award. CRISPY COREY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, split horses leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor share five wide on the line. BOLD TYPE chased outside, angled in a bit off the rail, came out in midstretch and was outfinished. CYPRESS SAM saved ground off the pace, continued inside through the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ONE FINE CAT allowed to settle off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally.
