GRASMERE PARK never far back and outside, looped the field four wide and drew off late while being kept to the task. STORMIN THRU stalked the early pace three wide, then came in slightly into the turn, gain a short lead at the five sixteenth pole, then weakened in the drive. INDIAN COURAGE was allowed to settle in the early going outside, then made a mild middle move three wide and gained contention into the stretch, then flattened out through the lane. PUT IT BACK OPIE set the early pace inside, then gave way. ESPIRIT DE MAR showed little. KAYDEE'S FLYER vied for the early lead from between rivals, was forced to check off heels into the turn, then faded. ORTHODONTIST well placed early, made a three wide move through the turn, then was not pressed through the lane while faltering badly. FREIGHTER trailed the field.
