IOYA BIGTIME tracked just off the leaders along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out to split foes entering the backstretch while moving to a stalking position just off the pacesetter, made a steady advance on the far turn to wrest command in upper stretch, then turned back a challenge from ROI LE ROY leaving the furlong marker under firm handling to edge clear late. The latter tracked the pace unhurried off the inside to the backstretch, angled in entering the far turn while moving to striking distance, split foes nearing upper stretch three deep, drew on terms with the winner nearing midstretch but was outfinished. HOODLUM tracked just outside the pacesetter as part of the second flight to the far turn, bid three wide nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the top pair and finished evenly late. ROB YOUNG tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to the backstretch, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO settled along the inside in the opening half, then made some mild progress between foes in late stages. JINGLE JANGLE was reserved well off the pace to the far turn, then passed some tiring rivals. TIO CHENCHO tracked the leaders off the inside behind the second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing response. CHIEF CHICAGO was a brief factor along the inside tracking the pacesetter, then steadily retreated racing through the far turn. SHARP ROMA went clear soon after the break, dictated the pace to the far turn and emptied out once headed.

TWO BEE came through close quarters just after the start to secure terms with several rivals near the lead, attended the pace between foes racing into the bend while not being asked for his best, shook clear when prompted in upper stretch and just held the challenge of STREET CONTENDER under firm encouragement. The latter tracked the leaders unhurried outside a rival from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, made a steady, three wide advance to challenge entering upper stretch and was going well late. STORM BOOT LARRY, forwardly placed three wide from the break, pressed the issue in that path into upper stretch and weakened when failing to match terms with the winner while continuing well enough to earn a share . KNIGHT SHOT tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside as part of the second flight and continued evenly into the lane. KING SNOOP flashed brief pace along the inside and gave way entering upper stretch. ALABAMA GOLD tracked the pace unhurried outside a foe in the last flight and never gained contention. ATHEIST was guided to the inside early but never mounted a serious challenge.

TATUM GIRL, held up outside a foe in second flight in the opening quarter, switched out to challenge three deep into upper stretch and missed second while no menace to the winner. ULTIMATE EVENT tracked the leaders unhurried in second flight along the inside and continued evenly into the stretch. LAGUNA AMIGA tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. ETERNAL SUNSHINE dropped back to the inside while unhurried in the opening stages, switched out five deep racing into upper stretch but made no impression.

LOVE THIS KITTEN forced inwards at the start, was collected to track between foes, shifted out a bit entering the turn to gain terms with the pacesetter three deep, moved to challenge that foe in upper stretch and narrowly prevailed between foes on the wire in an all out drive. ANGE GRISE was held up outside foes in the opening quarter, made a steady advance to striking distance racing three and four deep into upper stretch, drew on terms with the first flight leaving the furlong marker and was just outfinished. SWEET TIZZY LIZZY broke sharply, dictated the pace just off the inside to upper stretch, shifted out a bit racing through the lane and resisted the top pair to the end. TURTLE, bumped when in tight quarters just after the start, shifted off the inside to track the leaders between foes while under some reserve, shifted out in search of an opening nearing upper stretch while awaiting room, altered course to the inside leaving the furlong marker while being bumped by JUST BE THERE in late stages and couldn't quite gain terms with the leaders. JUST BE THERE broke readily, was taken off the pacesetter to stalk that foe along the inside racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch while moving to challenge, drifted out a bit bumping TURTLE in late stages and weakened a bit. MAGIC SHOES swerved inwards into the path of the eventual winner at the start, was shuffled back out of close quarters just after the start, saved ground on the bend, shifted five wide in upper stretch while gaining striking distance but made little impression on the leaders. KIDDING broke a step slowly, then was pinched back just after the start and never menaced thereafter.
