SEJANO bobbled a bit at the start, recovered quickly, raced unhurried while making her way to the inside tracking just off the second flight in the opening quarter, moved to striking distance after a half while shifting off the inside, then continued with a solid response to collar the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and edge clear under steady handling. SCORING CHICK was hustled clear of her foes along the inside from the break, held sway on a clear margin racing just off the inside into upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. BUZZ MY BELL was settled along the inside in the opening quarter, swung out four wide nearing the quarter mile marker to advance and continued willingly to close the gap on the top pair while earning a share. SIXTYSIX MARGAUX tracked the pace outside foes in second flight, made a brief, three wide bid in tandem with the eventual winner nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. BEAUTIFUL LORI was settled between foes in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend into upper stretch and continued evenly nearest the rail. SAY JAS tracked just off the pacesetter in second flight racing to the bend but emptied out after a half. SPECTACULR SPARKLE never seriously menaced.

GO GONE GIRL broke outwards bumping VAL CAPONI, was righted, moved readily to the fore along the inside dictating the pace, shook clear after a half and held sway to the end under steady pressure. TALKING AUDREY was settled in hand between foes early, angled inside after the opening quarter while making steady progress, shifted out four wide after six furlongs while continuing well but couldn't gain terms with the winner. DEE'S DANCING worked her way to the inside in the opening stages tracking well out of striking distance, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining some position, shifted out to split foes just off the inside nearing the furlong marker and continued willingly for a share. COOL GUT GIRL, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, lost some position to the leaders on the bend, then angled out nearing midstretch and made some late progress to improve her position. HANNAH SUE broke sharply, relinquished the lead to a rival nearing the six furlong marker, tracked that foe between rivals as part of the second flight racing into the bend but weakened in the last furlong when failing to gain terms with the winner. ANDI GATO GO gained position in the second flight near the inside early, was eased off the leaders racing though the backstretch, switched off the inside nearing upper stretch and made some mild progress between foes. ABLE tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch. NAN'S LILLIE advanced outside foes to gain a position in the second flight after the opening half, tracked the leader three deep to upper stretch but had no final response. BEAUTIFUL ZORA, reserved out of tight quarters at the start, never mounted a serious challenge. VAL CAPONI, bumped at the start, was settled into stride but never menaced thereafter.

UNO CHAPO was guided to the rail in the opening quarter to secure a tracking position racing just off the leaders, continued unhurried along the inside to the far turn, shifted out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and wrested command from NIC THE QUICK in late stages to prevail under firm handling. The latter moved in tandem with the winner racing to the first turn to gain a position outside that foe racing as part of the second flight to the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge three deep entering upper stretch, led between calls late but couldn't fend off his rival. SPIDER POWER (IRE) tracked the leaders unhurried between foes behind the second flight in the opening half, shifted out nearing the far turn to advance four deep racing into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. TURNPIKE TOMMY dictated the pace along the inside from the outset, turned back a challenge to go clear in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. CRATER MAKER bobbled a bit at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just outside the pacesetter to the backstretch, pressed that foe racing into upper stretch and gave way. MINISTER'S JOY was settled between foes in the opening half, shifted out a bit nearing upper stretch and made some belated progress three deep between foes. TOM ARCHDEACON, held up off the second flight along the inside racing to the first turn, angled out entering the far turn while making some progress, swung five wide entering upper stretch but had no final response. DAVID K was held up along the inside in the opening stages while racing in some traffic entering the backstretch, saved ground while steadily moving into striking distance nearing midstretch but was shuffled a bit when racing in tight quarters nearest the rail in the last sixteenth. GROUND HERO, reserved in hand for a half, never gained contention. BROKERAGE HOUSE, caught three and four deep racing to the backstretch outside the second flight was spent after a half.
