LIVIN LARGE sat reserved along the outside during the initial stages, entered the far turn from the three path but soon swung over one path closer to the inside, gradually ranged up to the leader under light encouragement, confronted that rival on even terms heading for the stretch, displaced the pacesetter quickly under energetic handling, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage then increased the winning margin while being kept busy. TYPHOON TYCOON within range, was asked for run nearing the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the lane and charged down the center of the course en route to winning the tight place photo. LUBASH forwardly placed, backed off, conceding the lead to a pair of opponents, staked the front runner under a stout hold, ducked inward midway on the far turn, angled back out in upper stretch, was set down but was outkicked. FRESHMAN DORM taken hold soon after leaving the starting gate, remained unhurried for over a half, was asked to pick up the pace, being put to a prolonged drive soon after entering the second bend, finished with good late energy. NEW YAWKER the early leader, yielded midway down the backstretch, tracked the front runner taking the inside route, was steadied midway on the far turn when LUBASH ducked inward, was guided to the outside a few strides later, came four wide into the lane, proved empty after being called upon. ASPIRE TO SILVER worked his way to the front midway on the backstretch, showed the way unchallenged until nearing the quarter pole, failed to duplicate the top one's burst of speed and steadily tired thereafter. LOFTY BANNER five wide at the head of the stretch, was outrun.

O'KID underwent a four wide journey, moved up to poke a head in front at the quarter pole, extended the advantage after being placed to a hard drive from the quarter pole to sixteenth pole. KARAKORUM ON BLACK tracked a foursome from the inside until the quarter pole, angled outward and displayed a mild rally to grab second. MY DADDIO raced three wide and tired. MORINE'S VICTORY lumbered along after leaving the gate, took the inside route until the five-sixteenths pole, improved position after turning for home, never posing a threat anytime. FOUR STAR GENERAL vied for the lead from the two path and gave way. WOLLASTON BAY broke behind the field after having leapt at the break, was guided over to the inside, rushed up along the rail left available by the lumbering MORINE'S VICTORY, showed the way towards the inside with three rivals in close proximity, folded turning for home.

ELDER SKATESMAN lumbered along the back of the pack during the run down the backstretch, while saving ground, made a steady advance during the run around the bend to catch up to the competition by the quarter pole, continued onward after being set down in upper stretch, made a slow motion angle to the outside of the strip around the eighth pole, then finished willingly under steady right handed encouragement to wear down MERLIN BAY and prove best. MERLIN BAY raced wide throughout, ranged up to the former runaway pacesetter approaching the quarter pole, wrested command by the time he reached the eighth pole, despite showing signs of wearying, wasn't able to stave off the top one's late challenge and had to settle for the place. ADAM BOY chased a runaway rival from the outside, had little left to make an impact during the stretch run, but was good enough to take the show. FIVE CASES urged on the turn, tired. FIVE BOROUGHS sped away to a be a runaway leader, continued to show the way on the front well off the inside until upper stretch, surrendered during the run through the furlong grounds and steadily tired thereafter. RELATIVELY READY never menaced.

BLAZING HONOR raced four wide around the turn, came out one additional path entering the stretch, took off in earnest after being called upon. closed readily on the front runners during the ensuing furlong, caught up to those rivals around the sixteenth pole, went by and edged clear, being flashed the whip from the right side in the late stages. DISARMING under a good hold along the outside for nearly a half mile, swung three wide into the stretch while being asked for a response, narrowed in on the leader, reached even terms at the same time the top one arrived on the scene, was beaten to the lead by that foe, then battled with determination against OFFICER FLIRT to earn the place. OFFICER FLIRT was bumped soundly from both sides at the break, recovered from that incident to take up a forward position, prompted the leader from the outside, issued a bid for the lead nearing the head of the stretch, fought her way to a clear advantage with a furlong to go, with a pair of rivals in hot pursuit, was joined up by them around the sixteenth pole, relinquished the lead soon afterwards, put up a good fight to end but had to settle for show honors. SOO'S PURSE bumped soundly at the break, saved ground until the quarter pole, and came home with good courage to earn a major share. PRINCESS CUGAT off the inside, swung wide into the lane, winding up five to six wide, finished willingly, outkicking mainly weak ones during the stretch drive. BESA ME POR FAVOR took the inside route, was lightly coaxed along during the run around the bend, had a brief wait behind traffic, wiggled into the two path upon reaching the quarter pole, was set down but lacked a solid closing response. SMARTY SISTER bumped at the start, made a three wide middle move but failed to sustain it after turning for home. RAW DAMASK three wide between rivals on the turn, failed to display a kick. INDIAN FLIRT bounced around between rivals at the break, wound up taking the overland route and gave way. AWEDACIOUS CAREN showed the way towards the inside for a half and stopped.
