OLD MAN BUCK bided his time along the outside during the initial half, advanced into contention during the run around the bend, was asked for run after turning for home, gained gradually on the pacesetter, collaring that one nearing the eighth pole, then drew off under steady encouragement. CHARING CROSS saved ground until the quarter pole and rallied mildly to procure the place. METULLA off the inside for nearly six furlongs, ducked inward and mustered up enough of a kick to grab the show. CORVO improved by out finishing mainly weak ones in the stretch. MR. UNSTOPPABLE raced three wide and tired. EARLY RESPONSE sped off under his own power, was rated on a very open lead from the two path, retreated after turning for home. SMILE OF SUCCESS offered little. FORTYNINEGEORGEST. never threatened.

MARGARITA FRIDAY within range under a good hold from the three path, swung four wide into the stretch, responded well to narrow in on the leader, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, then edged away. FAR ISLE well rated tracking the leader from the pocket, commenced her rally along the clear available alleyway at the quarter pole, loomed boldly with a furlong to go but was out finished. LUCIDA bobbed at the break, sat reserved for a half under a firm hold, then finished willingly after being asked for a response to take the show. HEY HEY MAMA rated prompted the pacesetter, lacked the necessary stretch response after being called upon. A NEW DAWN well rated towards the inside, drifted out to the two path turning for home, weakened during the final furlong. GROOVITUDE rank under restraint, had no stretch offering.

BRIDGE TO NOWHERE contently prompted the pacesetter three wide, ranged up to reach nearly even terms approaching the quarter pole, was briefly shaken off, then gained gradually during the final furlong under driving tactics to finally wrest the lead for good prior to reaching the wire. ALWAYS ON THE MOVE rated in the two path, was joined momentarily by the top one late on the turn, was put to encouragement and edged away again to a clear advantage, during the run through the furlong grounds, was put to the test for a second time by that rival leaving the sixteenth pole, failed to answer this challenge, yielding the lead a few strides before the end. WHEELSAREOFFTHEBUS bumped at the start, sat reserved in midpack, swung five wide into the lane and displayed a mild rally for the show. BEEN A PLEASURE rode the rail, was steadied in a bit tight amongst rivals at the nine-sixteenths, resumed his tracking role in short order, slipped off the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, angled four wide into the stretch, but lacked the necessary stretch response to finish in the money. GOLD CLOSE TO HOME ducked in on the turn and had no rally. SWEET SIGHT four wide around the turn, failed to reach a contending position. NEXT DAY trailed.

CRAFTY GEM spurred from the three path with PRIMED TO BE READY down the backstretch, shook free approaching the turn, edged away to a comfortable advantage during the run around the bend, was put to encouragement leaving the three-sixteenths pole, still held a sizeable lead at the eighth pole, then had enough left to stave off the determined runner up to preserve the decision. EAST COASTER always along the inside, was placed under urging midway around the turn, came home willingly to secure the place. MIGHTY IRISH raced along the outside, angled outward after PRIMED TO BE READY drifted inward under left handed pressure, momentarily gaining a hole to shoot through, had that pathway shut off by traffic problems again, wasted no time altering course back towards the inside, displayed good late energy en route for show honors. PRIMED TO BE READY duelled with the top one from the two path during the opening stages, backed off nearing the turn, swung out to the three path before resuming the chase, failed to keep pace on the turn, but held well enough to grab a major share. NAJARANS STAR swung four wide into the lane but could muster no significant rally. DONNA'S SANDEE raced three wide and tired.
