HOG'S HOLLOW chased outside a rival to the second turn, rallied outside leaving the second turn and drew out in the final furlong while remaining off the rail. TWEEBSTER found a comfortable stalking position leaving the first turn, chased outside a foe down the backstretch and rallied through the lane between horses to gain the place on the wire. SQUAD moved to the early lead between horses, opened up a large lead leaving the first turn, held the advantage to midstretch, weakened and lost second in the final yards. DUCANE saved ground around the first turn, chased inside the winner down the backstretch, entered the stretch between horses and could not make up the needed ground in the final furlong. GROVE PARK was without any early speed and was outrun to the stretch, improved his position in the lane between horses while no threat for the major awards. B'S LUCKY STRIKE chased outside down the backstretch, entered the lane three wide and was unable to make up ground in the final furlong. TALIAFERRO stalked the pacesetter on the inside to the lane, remained inside for the drive and fell back through the lane. BRAVO ZULU was squeezed slightly after the break, chased inside down the backstretch and without a rally in the drive.

ONE VOTE stalked four wide on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, angled in some leaving the bend, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead under left handed urging past midstretch and held gamely. CHANGING (ARG) sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch and set the pace inside, fought back through the final furlong and continued willingly. STAND TALL unhurried off the rail early, went outside leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. CHAVEZ RAVINE chased off the inside, split horses into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged late for third. STORMY GAME stalked between horses, steadied when bumped and in tight into the turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MY MAN MURF close up forcing the stalking the pace between rivals, steadied sharply when bumped between foes into the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RABBITPEAK settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WHIZER saved ground off the pace, split horses in deep stretch and also was not a threat. YOUTHFUL AMBITION chased outside, went five wide into the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. JUST HEAT sent inside to force then stalk the pace, steadied into the turn, was in tight again midway on the bend and also weakened.

GENUINE MAGIC broke in and a bit slowly then steadied when bumping with a rival, settled off the rail then outside a foe leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. SAANNEEN bumped at the start, stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. TIZ FOLLY three deep early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the turn and also weakened. MARY STRONG settled off the pace inside and saved ground to no avail.
