EX LOVER chased from behind down the backstretch, moved up inside MADAME ARABELLA on the second turn, came into the stretch three wide and rallied down the middle of the course to be up for the score. FASHION TREND stalked the pacesetter on the outside to the top of the lane, took over the lead at the furlong marker, battled to the wire and was outfinished late. IRISH TORRENT stalked on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, steadied on the inside while in tight at the furlong marker, recovered and was able to be a clear third at the wire. HELLO WALLS sped to the early lead, held the advantage to the top of the lane, came in to bother IRISH TORRENT and steadied at the furlong marker and weakened in the final furlong. MADAME ARABELLA chased outside a rival down the backstretch, began to weaken on the second turn and make no impact in the stretch drive. RAHBADABADOU hesitated at the start, drifted out on the first turn, was pulled up and vanned off. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident at the eighth pole but made no change when they ruled HELLO WALLS was responsible for the trouble. A claim of foul by rider of IRISH TORRENT against FASHION TREND for alleged interference in midstretch was not allowed by the stewards for the same reason.

POKOMOKE chased outside then alongside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead three deep a sixteenth out and proved best. FIRST QUEEN (GB) bobbed slightly at the start, settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out some past midstretch and picked up the show. MISSOULA sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then dueled inside on the turn and until deep stretch and just held third. SHINE'N TIME stalked outside a rival then bid alongside MISSOULA on the turn and into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, was between foes in deep stretch and was outfinished for the show. PRETTY KINZIE between foes early, settled a bit off the rail or outside a rival leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHERIE'S DREAM (GB) chased between horses then inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SAINT'S CROWN hopped slightly at the start, pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, was in a bit tight on the backstretch, continued to save ground tracking the leaders on the turn and into the stretch, then weakened. ENLIGHTENED LADY broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside and was outrun.

BLIND OPTIMISM stalked the pace off the rail, was between horses in deep stretch and lost third. YASUDA broke in a bit, sped to the early lead and drifted off the rail, angled in approaching the turn, set the pace inside, fought back in a bit tight in midstretch, then weakened.
