HOLY ABOVE up close and three wide, lacked the needed late response. SHE'S AN ALPHA GAM saved ground and advanced into midstretch then could not sustain the needed momentum. HULA PARTY raced near the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SCOUT EXCHANGE in tight early, raced in the three path into the lane and lacked a rally. GOODGIRL GONEWILD four wide into the turn, chased and raced five wide into the stretch then weakened in the drive.

FOREVER TANGO broke a bit awkwardly then hustled early, set the pace inside and weakened through the lane. CRISTIANE stumbled at the start, saved ground and lacked a rally. I'M WITH YOU lacked a response. HONKY TONK LADY four wide early, raced three wide into the far turn, was four wide again turning for home and lacked a bid. CHEROKEE LAKE up close early, raced between rivals into the far turn and tired. ITSMRBILLYTOYOU was outrun.
