GUNGA DAN was off the pace and saved ground to no avail. ROY'S BOYS raced in mid pack then lacked a rally.

DINO DINARO bumped at the break, was far back, gained ground on the far turn and swung wide then had a mild rally. POWERMOUSE stalked the pacesetters throughout then missed in a tight show photo. BRADY THOMAS well back then gained ground and finished willingly between but lost the show photo to two other rivals. MENSCH bobbed at the break, was off the pace and did not threaten after saving ground into the stretch. BELL'S FIRST LAD in touch from the outset, lacked the needed bid. LAMBEAU vied inside and was in the hunt into the stretch turn then faded. WHEEL WATCHER bumped at the break, was far back after being four wide in the early going, then lacked a rally.
