FLAMING GLORY broke sharply, set the pace under light rating racing to the bend and was roused to maintain his advantage in the last furlong. HOLY THURSDAY was held up just off the pacesetter near the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch and proved best of the others. THIEF, carried out at the start into the path of BLYDE RIVER BOY, was quickly righted to track just off the pacesetter between foes, couldn't gain terms with the winner and just lasted for a share. TAX AND SPEND broke a bit awkwardly, was roused to regain terms with the field in the opening stages, tracked between foes just off the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out a bit in late stages and just missed for a share. HE'S HOT SAUCE was a brief factor tracking the pacesetter three deep in second flight but steadily faded nearing the lane. BLYDE RIVER BOY, bumped at the start, was collected to track outside foes off the second flight racing to the bend but offered no rally. PROFESSOR HENNESSY swerved out sharply at the start into the path of THIEF, was settled between foes racing to the turn and steadily faded from contention.

THERE I GO secured terms with a rival on the pace soon after the break, attended the pace while inside that foe under firm rating, moved clear when given her cue in upper stretch and widened her margin in a ridden out effort. REASON TO WINK prompted the pace outside a rival from the outset, pressed that foe into upper stretch, proved no match in the last quarter and just lasted for second. UNCONDITIONAL settled near the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground gathering some momentum nearing upper stretch, produced her best stride late racing along the rail and just missed second. SUAVE DOTTIE M. tracked the leaders as part of the second flight along the inside, shifted out a bit in upper stretch and continued evenly. MUDDY GATOR tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded after a half. ETERNAL SUNSHINE ducked outwards at the start, was settled outside foes and never gained striking distance.

GILDED TREASURE, held up out of close quarters in the opening stages near the inside, switched outside foes leaving the midway point of the turn, was fanned five wide racing through the stretch but continued with a steady response to prevail on the wire under left handed pressure and strong handling. SANTA TRINITA tracked just off the first flight along the rail racing into the turn, angled out to challenge the pacesetter leaving midstretch, was carried out by that foe late, struck the front nearing the wire and just failed to contain the winner. RICHIESGIRLGOTGAME swerved in and out at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead along the inside, shook clear in upper stretch, drifted out late brushing SANTA TRINITA in the final sixteenth and just failed to contain the top pair. ZIPPIN ALONG angled inwards nearing the bend while gaining a tracking position between foes and made mild progress near the inside. SLAVIC PRINCESS tracked the leaders racing four wide into the turn and continued evenly in that path racing through the stretch. LOVES TO FLY tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight, bid three deep between foes entering upper stretch but flattened out late. PEARL RING worked her way to the inside early, saved ground on the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. JO'S FINALE was outpaced early. QUADRIGA flashed brief pace outside a rival racing into the bend but dropped out quickly entering upper stretch.

PRETTY SLIC CHICK broke readily, dictated the pace while angling nearer the inside racing to the bend, went clear when prompted entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. MISS FONTANA, forwardly placed while angling to the inside, stalked just off the pacesetter to upper stretch, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch and proved best of the others. HAPPY HENRIETTA was urged to secure a position outside a rival in second flight, pressed the winner nearing upper stretch, soon proved no match and weakened. SUGARED TOAST tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside racing to the bend, then continued evenly inside foes racing through the stretch. PRINCESS OF POWER was settled off the pace, angled three wide racing through the turn but had no closing bid. KEL'S DREAMER was settled along the inside early, switched out four wide entering upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SATIN SWEEP tracked just off the second flight outside a rival racing into the bend but came up empty after a half.

ICE CLIMBER was settled well off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out gathering momentum while drawing into striking distance racing through the far turn, bid four wide for command in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but narrowly prevailed for the place. ASTUTE tracked just off the second flight to the backstretch while angling to the inside, saved ground on the second bend, came through along the rail to challenge and was outfinished for the place. TRIPP O STEEL tracked the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight, bid for command leaving the far turn, couldn't match the winner and flattened out late. COLOR ME BLUE led the second flight along the inside to the backstretch, closed the gap to make a brief bid entering the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. ROCK HARD was settled tracking the leaders from well out of striking distance early and offered no rally. MACHO TORO was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch and soon trailed.

CAPTAIN PIEVO disputed the pace inside a rival from the outset, shook clear nearing upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge past the furlong marker but came up second best . BEHR FACT broke sharply, forced the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, lost some ground to that foe but made a second effort to close the gap late despite the effects of an apparent slipped saddle. POOF AND GONE tracked just off the second flight to the bend, advanced to striking distance racing through the turn, angled out four wide in upper stretch but had no final bid. GREELEY'S FORTUNE tracked the leaders along the inside to the turn but never gained striking distance. SUCHAFOOL saved ground to upper stretch but never seriously menaced. SOCKSQUICK veered out at the start losing position to the leaders and never menaced thereafter. MUST BE LUCKY showed little. UPTOWN SMOKEY JOE chased the leaders along the inside but emptied out after the opening quarter.
