HELLO HANDSOME between foes down the backstretch, pressed on the turn then was no match while holding the place. JAX MAXX lodged a four wide bid on the turn and finished willingly. BAD POWER bobbed slightly at the start, raced up close three wide and weakened in the drive. KING MAX chased early, saved ground and was steadied slightly on the turn then weakened in the drive. BOBADOS saved ground into the turn, raced off the inside into the lane and lacked the needed bid. POLLARD'S POWER moved in on the turn and saved ground turning for home then lacked the needed rally. D J COMPARI moved off the inside on the turn and lacked a bid. FLY STRAIGHT between rivals early, moved inside on the turn and lacked a response. SUNNY DEFRERE trailed early and lacked a rally. OAKRIDGE RED went wide on the turn and was eased up. BUBBA JONES showed little.

BELLS OF CONCERTO chased four wide, bid between rivals at the quarter pole, dueled past the furlong marker and was outfinished. LELA away alertly, showed good speed outside and weakened in the stretch. BIALY bobbled and was bumped at the break, chased between rivals and had no rally. POWDERED SUGAR vied inside and tired. YANKEE EMPRESS was bumped at the start, raced inside and failed to respond. ELITE CLASS raced off the rail and failed to threaten. VAPORIZE chased three wide and gave way.

MANTECA well placed outside, was asked for run on the final turn and lacked the needed late response. INDIAN DANCE trailed and inside into the far turn, raced just off the rail into the stretch and offered a belated gain. ARSON SQUAD stumbled at the start and saved ground early, raced between rivals briefly entering the far turn, was just off the rail turning for home and lacked the needed response. HERMOSILLO moved inside on the clubhouse turn and set the early pace then weakened through the lane. PAMPERED SIR well placed early and just off the inside, weakened on the final turn.
